# Sacramental Preparation & Information Infant Baptism

Parents must be members of St. James for at least 3 months or have the pastor's permission and must complete the Belonging online course through Ascension Press as preparation. Both parents and Godparents are required to take the online course. For any questions, please refer to our St. James the Apostle website at stjamesapostlecatholicchurch.com. Baptisms are normally celebrated on the first and second Saturday of the month at 10:30am.

#### **First Holy Communion**

Children in the second grade and active in the Faith Formation program for two consecutive years are eligible to enroll in the sacramental preparation program. Special preparation sessions are held throughout the year before the reception of these sacraments. Contact the Faith Formation office 770-957-5441 ext.108.

#### Confirmation

Youth in the 10th grade or older and active in the teen program of the parish for at least two consecutive years will be eligible to register for Confirmation. Contact the Youth Ministry office at 770-957-5441 ext. 110 for more information.

#### **Anointing of the Sick**


Contact the Parish Office to make arrangements. If this is an emergency situation after hours, please call the Parish Office and press "1" for a sacramental emergency.



# **Weekly Reflection**

#### Cursillo

Many years ago a good friend in our parish asked me if I would be interested in attending a Cursillo weekend. I had no idea what a Cursillo weekend was and so I was reluctant to say yes. This friend explained that Cursillo (pronounced Cur-see-yo) is a weekend in which one is offered an opportunity to discuss your faith; discover your unique gifts from God; examine your conscience so as to foster new spiritual growth; discover that we are on a journey to become more Christ like; and to realize ways to impact your community and to bring the presence of Christ to all you meet.

These all sounded like and are wonderful things that I wanted to experience... but I still said no, maybe some other time. Well years went by and finally I reluctantly said yes to attending the Cursillo weekend. What was I afraid of? Why did I say no so many times? I am not sure, but I can tell you that when I did say yes and attended the Weekend it was a life changing, spiritually invigorating experience.

As I dug in more to the Cursillo Movement I found that was started by a group of priests and laymen in Majorca, Spain around 1947. They felt that something had to be done to invigorate the Church and so they formulated this "short course" in Christianity to help Catholics in good standing with the church become even better Catholics! During the weekend there are talks, discussions, sharing, singing, joking, laughter and prayer. The talks are centered on the true meaning of Grace, the Sacraments, the Mass, the nature and need for prayer, living one's daily life in union with God and introducing Christ to others by word and deed. The atmosphere of the three days is one of Joy and Grace. Mass is celebrated every day and confessions are heard. Basically the Weekend is centered on the Catholic Church's beliefs and the Sacraments.

The Atlanta Catholic Cursillo Movement is hosting two upcoming weekend encounters at the Monastery of the Holy Spirit in Conyers. For men, September 25-28, 2025, and for women, October 2-5, 2025. For more information, please contact Julie Gonzalez 678-628-3322.
