# Sacramental Preparation & Information Infant Baptism

Parents must be members of St. James for at least 3 months or have the pastor's permission and must complete the Belonging online course through Ascension Press as preparation. Both parents and Godparents are required to take the online course. For any questions, please refer to our St. James the Apostle website at stjamesapostlecatholicchurch.com. Baptisms are normally celebrated on the first and second Saturday of the month at 10:30am.

#### **First Holy Communion**

Children in the second grade and active in the Faith Formation program for two consecutive years are eligible to enroll in the sacramental preparation program. Special preparation sessions are held throughout the year before the reception of these sacraments. Contact the Faith Formation office 770-957-5441 ext.108.

#### **Confirmation**

Youth in the 10th grade or older and active in the teen program of the parish for at least two consecutive years will be eligible to register for Confirmation. Contact the Youth Ministry office at 770-957-5441 ext. 110 for more information.

#### August 3, 2025 **Why Sunday Mass Matters**

Sunday isn't just a "day off"—it's the Lord's Day. From the earliest days of Christianity, believers gathered on Sunday to break bread, hear the Word, and celebrate the Resurrection. The Catechism reminds us: "The Sunday Eucharist is the foundation and confirmation of all Christian practice" (CCC 2181).

But it's more than an obligation—it's an invitation. At Sunday Mass, we encounter Jesus in the Liturgy of the Word and most profoundly in the Eucharist. We don't just remember the Last Supper; we are mystically present at it. Christ feeds us with His very Body and Blood, offering grace and strength for the week ahead.

In a busy, noisy world, Sunday Mass reminds us who we are and Whose we are. It re-centers our hearts and reorients our priorities. When we miss Mass, we miss more than a ritual—we miss a divine encounter.

Make Sunday holy. Come not just because you "have to," but because God is waiting to meet you there.
